Short Paper Presentation Submission Requirements

Purpose: To provide a forum for concise presentation of original research related to violence and/or abuse and health and the health care system.

Papers must be reports of original research related to violence and/or abuse and health. The research to be described may pertain to clinical, economic, health systems, curricular, or faculty development issues in, or aspects of, violence and abuse. (Note: The reviewers may suggest a paper be presented in the Short Paper or Poster Presentation categories.)

Time: 15 minutes maximum (10-minute presentation, 5-minute discussion)

The first several web pages that you fill in are the same for all submission categories.

When using the online submission application, please remember the following:

Each screen of the on-line submission process must be completed within 20 minutes of loading that web page. If you do not complete entering your data for that page within 20 minutes, you may “time out.” If you time out, you will have to start over.

You will need to know the full name, mailing address, phone number, and email for each additional presenter.

Titles may be a maximum of 15 words and 255 characters (including spaces).

Abstracts may be a maximum of 250 words and should be suitable for wide dissemination and/or publication. AVA intends to arrange for the publication of the selected abstracts in a journal and in the conference proceedings. (Please note that some words that contain a hyphen or apostrophe will be counted as two words.

Answers to the proposal questions may be a maximum of 1,500 characters including spaces (approx. 300 words).

We recommend you copy and paste your abstract and other lengthy information from another program such as Microsoft Word. If you do copy and paste, remember that formatting commands (table, bold, paragraph indent, auto numbering, etc) and symbols (for example ™ ÿ ÿ ) are not transferred. The best approach is to save your information as plain text, edit it for appearance and then copy and paste the plain text into the online submission fields.

After you complete all the fields on these web pages, you will be sent a confirmation email to the email address provided for the principal presenter. If the principal presenter does NOT receive a confirming email within 24 hours, we have NOT successfully recorded the submission. Check your input carefully. We will not modify, edit, spell check or otherwise change your input prior to sending your submission to the AVA reviewers. If you notice something significant that must be changed after you have completed the submission process, please contact Bruce Phillips.

All presenters should be available to present during all dates of the conference.

Submissions must be entered online at [www.stfm.org/ava](http://www.stfm.org/ava) no later than October 1, 2008.

All abstracts and proposals must be blinded regarding institution(s), presenter(s), and geographic location(s). Submissions that are not properly blinded will not be reviewed or accepted.

Submissions must explicitly follow the directions for the proposed category. Requirements are category specific and are listed on the submission Web site. Incomplete submissions will not be reviewed.

Presenters are limited to a maximum of three submissions. Presentations done in collaboration with other schools will not be included in this total. Do not submit the same proposal for different session formats. The reviewers may request that a paper be presented in a different session format.

Each submission will be reviewed by the AVA Scientific Review Committee and evaluated on the criteria listed below.

- Relevance to violence and abuse, research and education
- Relevance to the conference theme
- New knowledge and ideas

- Generalizability and transferability to other settings/institutions
- Presence of results and outcomes

Proposals should use language that is listener sensitive, including gender neutral terms and avoidance of expressions that degrade participants and/or patients and families.

All presenters will be required to register for the conference and pay the applicable registration fee. Please advise co-presenters of this policy.
